Cemetery Etiquette

The following rules have been adopted by the Board of Aldermen as a reminder of ways to help in maintaining the beauty and serenity of the Crystal Springs City Cemetery. Several of the rules are also in place to protect the staff as they maintain the grounds.

- Please remember that the cemetery is open to visitors only during the daylight hours and onehalf hour after sunset.
- Please stay in designed driveways and do not disturb memorials or artifacts.
- Please show respect for the dead and for their families. Do not intrude on funeral or memorial services.
- Do not bring alcohol, firearms, or entertainment items (radios, CD players, etc.) into the cemetery.
- Skateboards, Go-carts, motorized scooters and ATVs are not permitted.
- Keep your pets on a leash and clean up after them.
- Please do not litter. (This includes cigarette butts.)
- Artificial flowers should be removed if faded. Seasonal arrangements and decorations (Christmas, Valentines, etc.) should be removed 30 days after the holiday.
- Loose objects such as wooden boxes, glass jars, toys, etc. should not be placed on graves as they pose a danger to the workers cutting around gravesites.

The Crystal Springs Cemetery Association supports the needs of the City Cemetery. With the guidance of a cemetery preservationist, repairs and maintenance needs are undertaken.
