SET-UP TIME: Displays may be set up on Friday, June 28, 2019, after 6:00 p.m. Saturday, June 29, displays must be set up by 8:00 a.m. and remain until 3:00 p.m. All vendor vehicles must be removed from exhibit area by 8:30 a.m. Ample parking space is available close by.

VENDORS MAY NOT LOAD VEHICLES UNTIL AFTER 3:00 P.M. ON SATURDAY, JUNE 29, 2019
