LOCATION: Vendors will be assigned spaces in downtown Crystal Springs on Marion Ave. and Georgetown Street

- Flea Market Space: 12x12' - \$65.00 - \$10.00 extra for electricity
- Snack Vendors: 12x12' - \$75.00 - \$10.00 extra for electricity
- Games, Jump Houses, etc.: \$135.00 – this will cover electricity
- Food and Drink Vendors: 20x20'- \$200.00 – 220 hook up - \$240.00

RESTRICTIONS: No fireworks, “poppers,” “silly string,” or laser pointers, PLEASE.

SET-UP TIME: Displays may be set up on Friday, June 24, 2022, after 6:00 p.m. Saturday, June 25, displays must be set up by 7:30 a.m. and remain until 3:00 p.m. All vendor vehicles must be removed from exhibit area by 8:00 a.m. Ample parking space is available close by.

VENDORS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SET UP BEFORE 6:00 P.M. ON FRIDAY, JUNE 24, 2022. VENDORS MAY NOT LOAD VEHICLES UNTIL AFTER 3:00 P.M. ON SATURDAY, JUNE 25, 2022.
